Cuando Maria espanto al perro el perro salio corriendo y el otro perrito se escondio atras de la nina.





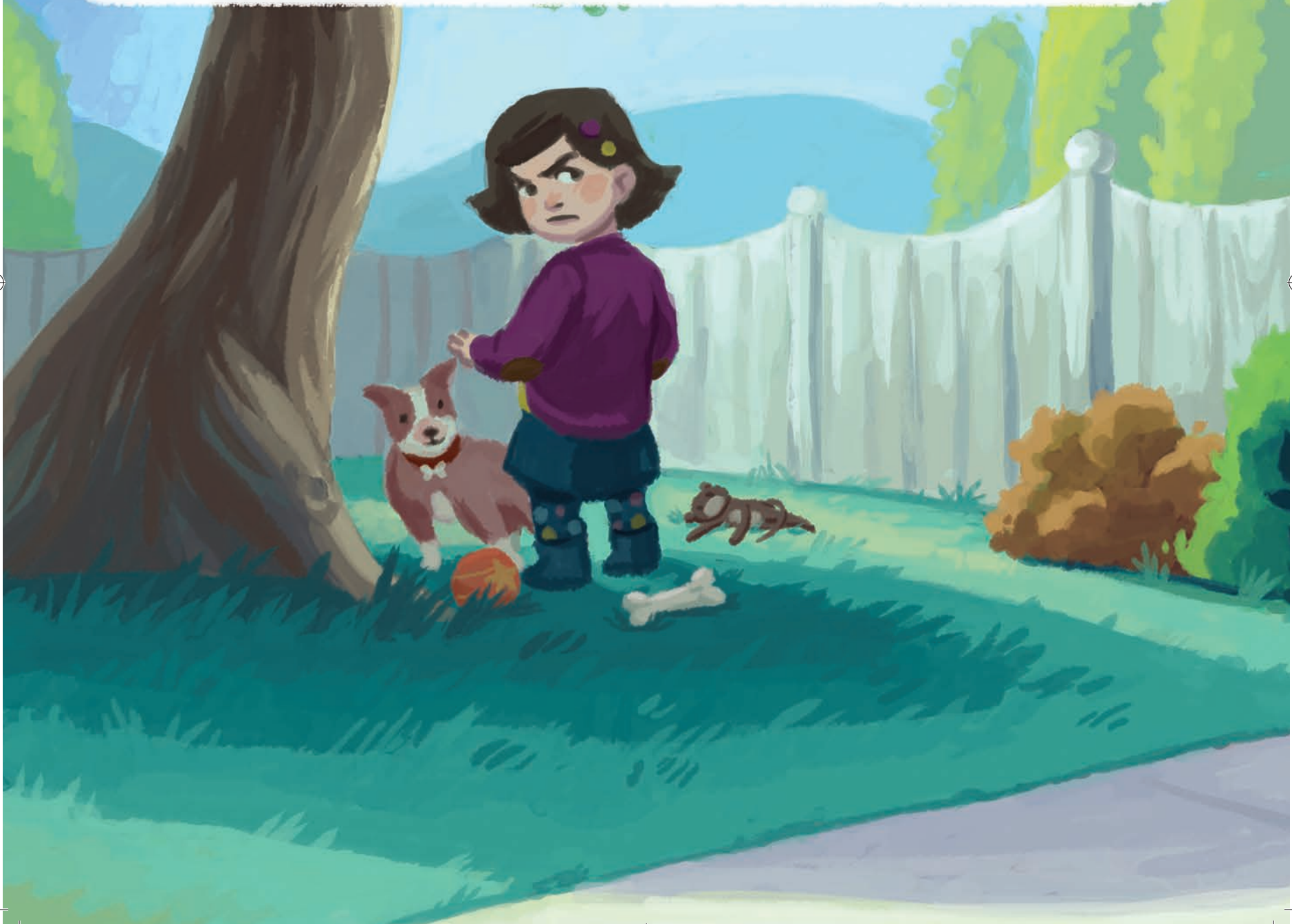
La nina iba de camino a su casa y el perro la comenzo seguir.


